

Tucked Fabric Ornaments

Supplies Needed:

- Christmas Fabric
- Scissors
- 3" Styrofoam ball (the rough type not the smooth type)
- Knife (like a butter knife or pairing knife)
- Ribbon for a bow and to hang ornament
- Embellishment for the top



Mark lines or shapes in the Styrofoam ball – or - cut shapes randomly as you go. Cut into the Styrofoam about 1/4" deep. Cover that area with a piece of fabric that fits the shape that you just cut, with at least 1/4" or more overhang. Tuck the overhanging fabric into the cut with the back of your knife. Mark out or cut another section and repeat the process until the ball is completely cover with your fabric.

Use a piece of ribbon to make a hanger and either glue or pin it in place. Embellish the top if you like. You can also use thin ribbon or cord to outline each section. Either glue or pin in place.
